

Team Delirium Wins Mountain Rage '98/Lake Powell

Lake Powell, Ariz. — About 41 hours after leaving Page, Arizona on foot just after midnight Saturday morning, November 7, Team Delirium returned to Page for the finish to win the second Four Winds Adventure Race: The Mountain Rage Series.

Led by team captain Kiviok Hight (Cortez, Colo.), the five-person squad included Kimberly Maxwell (Helena, Mont.), Louis Perron (Rocklin, Calif.), Tony Silva (Rocklin, Calif.) and Bill Watters (Fair Oaks, Calif.).

Finishing in a tie for second in the five-person category were Teams Olympia and Houston. Team Lobo won the three-person division, followed by Teams Aramark and Scramblers, respectively.

The course covered approximately 120 miles on and around Lake Powell and was highlighted by a dramatic 1,100-foot rappel off the Romana Mesa. Venues also included canoeing/kayaking, mountain biking, rappelling, ascending, hiking and climbing, and orienteering.

Because of local agency constraints, two alternate courses were offered to the teams that didn't make the rappel site by sundown Saturday night. Winning the rappel/paddling alternate course — first through third respectively — were Teams Lobo, Aramark and Olympia. Team Houston won the bike/paddling alternate course.

The company's next Mountain Rage Series race will return to Lake Roosevelt, Ariz. March 20-21, 1999.
