

FOUR WINDS '99/WYOMING RESCHEDULED

Sedona, Ariz. — As a result of snowed in and washed out access roads that will not be ready or repaired until late summer, Four Winds '99: The USA Supreme Adventure Race/Wyoming has been rescheduled for Aug. 14-21.

Unusually late winter-like conditions in Western Wyoming, including snow flurries in May, have affected the expedition-level course, specifically access roads critical to providing safety, medical and racer transition support. After considerable research, advisement from all agencies involved (forest service personnel in several districts and outfitters) and a hoped-for improvement in the weather, Four Winds organizers made the crucial decision in the best interest of the racers.

The third annual event, the longest-running adventure race in the U.S., will offer athletes a 350-plus mile challenging course featuring seven to eight days of trekking, horseback riding, mountain biking, paddling, rappelling, ascending and navigating.
