Ever dream of soaring in the sky? Flying a **powered parachute (powerchute)** is one of the most exciting air sports available to the regular guy, in one of the safest aircraft you can fly. Racers will take to the air in this year's Four Winds USA Supreme Adventure Race, presented by The North Face®. Alliant Aviation, makers of *Destiny*-brand powered parachutes, announced its sponsorship role in the Four Winds USA Supreme Adventure Race Park City Utah 2003.

John Rivers, Vice President Sales & Marketing, Alliant Aviation, said, "We are very excited to be a part of this race. This will be the first time in aviation history and in adventure racing history that a part of the race will be flown in (Destiny) powered parachutes. This is a great event and a great chance for our two sports to come together."

Racers felt the exhilaration of motoring down earthen or grassy runways to gently lift in the air, soar across a racecourse charted for scenic fun and excitement as they powerchuted through the air flight venue of the 2003 Four Winds USA Supreme Adventure Race, presented by The North Face®. The ecstasy of gliding through the air, choosing sky paths to sail above the landscape, navigating the race course from the air, turning and swooping in on the next landing zone with vital team info thrilled competitors who took to the skies in a powerchute.



"**Americas Adventure Race**," the Four Winds USA Supreme Adventure Race presented by The North Face®, was held August 14

- 21st 2003, based out of internationally famous travel destination Park City, Utah. The "Supreme" continues as the original true expedition-level adventure race in the US. In the 2003, Four Winds USA Supreme Adventure Race, presented by The North Face®, competitors summited the mountains surrounding Park City and raced across the region in ways never before attempted or seen in the sport of adventure racing. The "Supreme" included such venues and skills as mountain biking, flat water paddling, swimming, horseback riding, rappelling, trekking navigating - *and a brand new, never-done-before in an adventure race venue - powered parachuting*. Four Winds again took a bold step into new territory with the introduction of the high-flying addition.

Certification was required for the powerchuting portion of this years "Supreme". Teams had access to the Alliant certification-training network of BFI and AFI Flight instructors throughout the US as well as the new Four Winds flight training facility in Sedona Arizona for race certifications. Each team was required to have at least one member trained and certified in powerchuting. All powerchuting conformed to the Federal Aviation Administration rules and regulations and exemptions as granted under FAR 103 and exemption # 6080 which outlines the flight rules for ultra light aircraft.
